All global suppliers receiving delivery schedules and purchase documents via Exostar Supply Chain Platform and Rolls-Royce Enterprise Supply Chain Platform

Introduction:

Supply Chain Platform (SCP), provided by Exostar, is a web-based solution that facilitates the electronic transfer of documents, allowing Rolls-Royce to release and communicate order requirements, demand forecasts and schedule changes with our global supply base electronically.

Exostar is upgrading and combining the Supply Chain Platform and Rolls-Royce Enterprise Supply Chain Platform applications. The new platform is a software upgrade to these applications and will involve changes and enhancements to the user interface and output files.

All active users will be migrated to the new version of the application during March 2013. You will receive further details about the implementation leading up to the "go live" date.

Until you are migrated to the new Enterprise Supply Chain Platform you will continue to receive your schedules and orders as normal through Exostar.

As the user interface for the new Supply Chain Platform system is different to the current applications, we recommend that ALL users participate in Exostar training sessions.

As you get closer to the "go live", Exostar will communicate the dates and times of the training sessions (via web conference) to help prepare you for using this new application. Training sessions will be available week commencing 11th March for six weeks and training material will be posted on the Exostar website.
