Introduction:

Rolls-Royce has partnerships with University Technology Centres (UTCs) and routinely engages on projects to improve our current engine architecture and performance, as well as driving simplification for our design methods and tools for future applications. One of the projects being commenced is the validation of an engine vibration model used for the Pearl 700 programme.

For model validation and verification full-scale and/or sub-scale engine tests will be run at the UTCs.
