# **Civil Aerospace Operations Summer Shutdown**

#### Scope/Applicability:

All suppliers within the Rolls-Royce Civil Aerospace Supply Chain.

### Dear Supply Partner,

We are planning a 10 day operational shutdown, which applies to our Civil Aerospace facilities in the UK from 26 July until 8 August 2021. During this period, most of our colleagues working in Civil Aerospace will be on leave and uncontactable.

#### Which facilities are in scope and what do you need to know?

The shutdown will include:

- Our Derby Assembly & Test facility
- Derby Engine Overhaul Services
- UK Manufacturing Plants (excluding Hucknall which has transferred to ITP)
- Some elements of our Oberursel facility in Rolls-Royce Deutschland.

It is important to note that we will continue to assemble and test engines at our Dahlewitz facility as we remain focussed on supporting our Business Aviation business. Defence and other plants not listed are unaffected.

In preparedness for the shutdown, we have taken several steps to ensure the pause in production will not impact on the smooth delivery of engines to our customers.

### What will happen to demand and logistics?

- Demand for parts into Derby Assembly & Test (SAP plant 1202) and Derby Experimental (SAP plant 1201) during the shutdown period has been pulled forward.
- Demand for spare parts into Derby (Plant 1203) has not been changed and together with the non UK MRO network will continue to operate and accept deliveries during the period
- Demand for parts into SATU OE (plant 4110), Dahlewitz OE (plant 3102), Defence (plants 1101, 1102, 1103) and Power Systems has not been changed and will continue to accept deliveries during the period.

The specific demand signal which you will see for the above plants (and for raw material into manufacturing plants) is currently being re-planned by our Supplier Management Teams and will be updated in due course.
