Phase 1 suppliers have been licensed and are operating the system, SABRe FAIR and Component Proving Process mandated that all suppliers that are trained and licensed to use the system, must use this as the only method to submit FAIR's / LAIR's into Rolls-Royce.

Phase 1 was a great success, FAIR Right First Time from the Supply Chain has increased by 63%, and Lead Time of FAIR clearance within Rolls-Royce has reduced by 77%. Usage of the system has therefore demonstrated clear advantages to both Rolls-Royce and the Supply Chain in submitting and processing FAIR's / LAIR's.

Suppliers have been selected for Phase 2 deployment, and the selected Engineers will be contacted directly by Rolls-Royce to be trained and licensed to use the system.
