Dear Supply Partner,

The Protection, Packaging & Labelling (PPL) Requirements Document exists to formally communicate requirements and expectations to the global supply chain related to the protection, packaging and labelling of Rolls-Royce products.

The PPL Document has been revised to Issue 31 and has been published on the Global Supplier Portal. A summary of the key changes are as follows:

- Update of MRO related requirements
- Addition of Country of Origin requirements for packaging labels
- Clarification of metallic preservation colour coded label requirements
- Update to Manifest Information requirements to refer to Matrix
- Updates to requirements for shipments with multiple serial numbers
- Addition of requirement to heat seal grip sealed bags
- Emphasis on HS&E importance of packaging.
