Introduction:

Per SABRe section 8.5.1.7, when the production definition specifies RRES 90000 (Engineering Control of Production Source and Method) and it is deemed required, an MVA (Method Verification Approval) form is to be submitted. One requirement of the form is to determine whether a FAIR (First Article Inspection Report) is required. This decision has now been moved to Section A of the form and is to be filled out by the manufacturer/supplier using the evaluation criteria found in AS9102 (First Article Inspection Requirements).

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Action Required:

- When an MVA is to be submitted, ensure the latest MVA form is being used. The new revision of this form with the updated change described above is version 1.11. This can be found in the Forms, Briefs, and Guidance Section 8.5.1.7 Fixed Production Methods on the Rolls Royce Global Supplier Portal.
- When filling out Section A of the MVA form, the decision to require a FAIR is in accordance with AS9102 and determined by the manufacturer/supplier. The Rolls Royce Technical Authority will agree with confirmation by completing Section A or will return with further discussion on the FAIR decision.
