**Scope/Applicability:** All suppliers supporting U.S. Government subcontracts issued by Rolls-Royce North America (and subsidiaries thereof), except those where the place of delivery or performance is outside the United States.

**Dear Supply Partner,**

As you are aware, pursuant to presidential executive order, the U.S. Government has implemented FAR 52.222-90 Addressing DEI Discrimination by Federal Contractors for both new and existing contracts and subcontracts.

All Rolls-Royce suppliers are required to comply with applicable law, including non-discrimination statutes, rules and regulations per the Rolls-Royce Global Supplier Code of Conduct and contracted terms and conditions.
