We are writing to notify you that we are temporarily postponing the launch of our new electronic Definition Alteration Request (e-DAR) system whilst we confirm a final licence with the United States Department of Defense.

We are working hard to gain the final approval and will keep you up to date with progress, but in the meantime, please continue to submit DARs via the current process. We'll update you on envisaged timescales at the next Global Supplier WebEx in August.

The reason for this pause on the e-DAR system is to gain formal confirmation that the system is fully compliant with the regional and Regulatory requirements.
