## Prohibited Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services

### Scope/Applicability:

All Rolls-Royce Suppliers with US Department of Defense subcontracts

### Dear Supply Partner,

Section 889(1)(a) of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (Pub. L. 115-232) prohibits any U.S. Government contractor from using or providing to the Government any equipment, system, or service that uses **covered telecommunications equipment or services** as more specifically described in Federal Acquisition Regulation 52.204-25, "Prohibition on Contracting for Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services." Please note, this prohibition applies to the use of covered telecommunications equipment or services, regardless of whether that use is in performance of work under a Federal contract.

In an effort to promote national security and comply with FAR 52.204-25, you are being requested to immediately notify Rolls-Royce if **you use** any **covered telecommunications equipment or services** or any product or service you deliver or provide to Rolls-Royce **will contain** one or more **covered telecommunications equipment or services**. Failure to notify Rolls-Royce of prohibited telecommunication equipment or services may result in your inability to continue work on a Federal contract and/or breach of your agreement with Rolls-Royce.
