### Introduction:

We (Rolls-Royce plc) wish to make our supply chain aware of a Temporary Denial Order notification issued by the United States (US) Department of Commerce's Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) relating to the ongoing efforts to illegally export civilian Airbus aircraft (A340-600 aircraft which carry Rolls-Royce Trent 500 engines) from the US by Al Naser Airlines (Iraq) to Mahan Air in Iran, in violation of the US Export Administration Regulations (EAR).

We are committed to compliance with the strategic export control laws, regulations and procedures of all relevant jurisdictions and regimes in which it operates.
