**Scope/Applicability:**

All suppliers within the Rolls-Royce aerospace supply chain.

**Introduction:**

DIN EN 9100 requires Rolls-Royce to make available the latest identification and revision level of specifications, drawings, process requirements, inspection/verification instructions and any other relevant technical data to our suppliers. This is to ensure that our suppliers operate to the latest revision of component definition, in line with the latest Rolls-Royce statement of work. To enable you to comply with this requirement we will upload a drawing report, including the current drawing revision level, on the [Global Supplier Portal](#) (GSP) on a quarterly basis.

The report will cover component definitions for Rolls-Royce Deutschland (RRD) and Rolls-Royce United Kingdom (RRUK) engine programs. For Rolls-Royce North America (RRNA) engine projects the details will be submitted as usual via the Supplier Management Team (SMT) contacts and as part of the purchase document.

All suppliers within the Rolls-Royce aerospace supply chain are required to carry out a regular review and verification of the drawing and revision level to ensure they are operating to the latest drawing status.

Suppliers are requested to check the latest revision level listed in the drawing report, available now through the Rolls-Royce [Global Supplier Portal](#) in the section "Global Standards and Specifications" (go directly to the list by clicking [here](#)).
