Introduction:

As part of the Maintenance Repair and Overhaul (MRO) Network coming together to establish a set of contractual Quality requirements which will assist in standardising and improving 'our' Quality Performance for the complete Rolls-Royce MRO network, a new interface document which is specific to Maintenance Repair and Overhaul (MRO) has been created. This will supersede SABRe 3 for MRO to ensure all Civil Services Suppliers meet the requirements of Rolls-Royce Services, sharing the good practices across the Customer to Customer (C2C) landscape to provide a sound Quality performance to our Airline Customers.
