### Scope/Applicability:

All Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) Suppliers and Partners within Rolls-Royce Civil Services and Business Aviation.


### Introduction:

Following on from NTS 539 and the feedback from our supply chain, this NTS now communicates the final draft of a consolidated “SABRe MRO” document and further detail of the implementation plan. The purpose of the “SABRe MRO” document is to formally communicate the specific Rolls-Royce requirements and expectations to the Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) external supply chain.

### Improvements in SABRe MRO include:

- Dedicated requirements document for MRO
- Using MRO regulatory requirements (PART 145) as a baseline/structure
- Using AS9110 as the primary reference
- Using applicable aerospace standards e.g. AS13100 where suitable for MRO
- Focus on Rolls-Royce complimentary requirement hence reducing duplication

For Rolls-Royce “Civil Services” and “Business Aviation” SABRe MRO replaces SABRe 3. The new SABRe MRO document is scheduled to become executive from 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2022. As a further step, it is planned, that “Defence” MRO activity will be included in in this SABRe MRO document in the future, but until advised otherwise SABRe 3 will remain applicable for Defence MRO activities.

Communication of the final draft is via the Rolls-Royce Supplier Management Teams. The executive version will be published via the RR Supplier Portal.

### Action Required:

Rolls-Royce “Civil Services” and “Business Aviation” MRO Suppliers and Partners are required to:

- Review the SABRe MRO requirements and feedback questions or final concerns/comments to the Rolls-Royce MRO SABRe focal point; Stephen Brown via [Stephen.Brown6@Rolls-Royce.com](mailto:Stephen.Brown6@Rolls-Royce.com) or via your respective Supplier Management Team by 22nd January 2022.
