### Introduction:

This notification is to inform you that we intend to update our Quality Management Document to GS3001 V24. The aim of the update is to relax the quality requirements on our less important parts and strengthen the requirements on more important parts.

The new draft document, which will be published in 3 parts (as detailed below), and will be available on Forum Pass and the Global Supplier Portal (GSP) week commencing 10th July:

- GS3001 – NP (Nuclear Products)
- GS3001 – SPP (Secondary Propulsion Products)
- GS3001 – QAP (Quality Assurance graded Products)

A supplier ballot of the new documents will take place through July – Sept 2023 and our aspiration is to request compliance from 2<sup>nd</sup> Oct, 2023.

### Action Required:

- Suppliers are requested to continue to comply with GS3001 V23 Add2 throughout July – Sept, 2023
- RRSL ME-P's or ME(ESC) will arrange training for supplier technical and quality teams
- Suppliers are requested to review and feedback any concerns related to the new documents via ME-P or ME(ESC) by the 8<sup>th</sup> Sept, 23 (ballot closing date)
- GS3001 V24 (subject to feedback) will 'go live' on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Oct, 2023
